On 17 January, the Regained project partners met in Kaunas to discuss the ongoing implementation of the project results. Based on the interviews and focus groups' results, the YOUTH REGAINED Good practice guide is prepared for local partnership networks with professionals created. The partners discussed the development and piloting of the YOUTH REGAINED e-course, and agreed on dissemination activities and quality assurance methods.

It is based on a one-year research activities in project partner countries - Romania, Greece, Lithuania, Cyprus, Ireland, and Spain, looking at the national juvenile justice systems and how do they connect with the educational systems.



The Good Practice Guide includes:

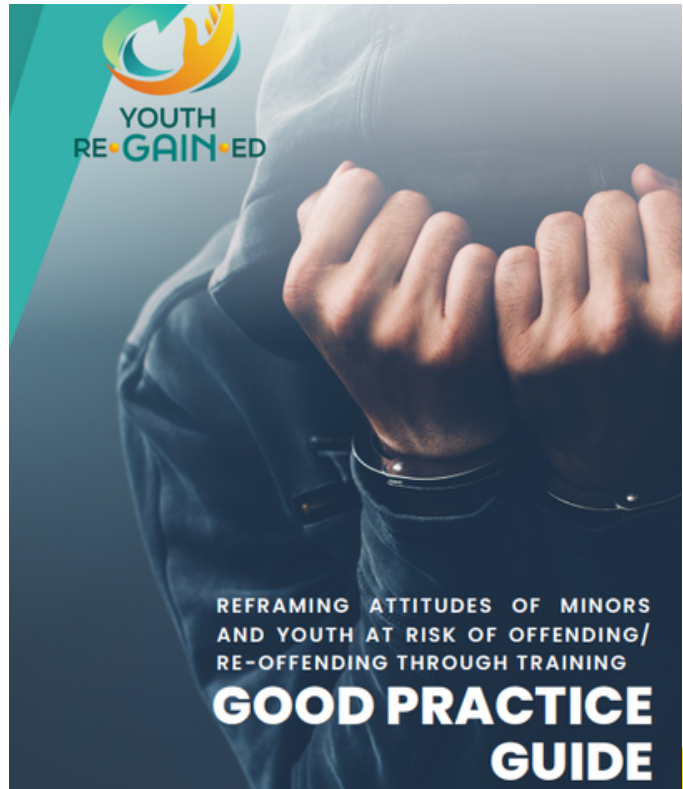
- The definitions on various terms and phenomena in partner countries: Juvenile Offenders, Reintegration Of Youth Offenders, Youth Offenders Awareness-Raising Practices, Youth Policies, Education On Soft Skills, Alternative Education, Informal Education, Non-Formal Education, Key Competencies.
- The INSPIRING Educational PRACTICES in partner countries.

The Guide will be translated into Romanian, Lithuanian, Greek and Spanish languages.

Current activities:

The project partners are currently working on:

YOUTH REGAINED e-course, which is going to be developed and piloted by June 2023. The course is dedicated to young people in conflict with the Law and also to their educators.



Different materials will be developed for the training, i.e. with:

- No direct access to juvenile learners;
- Direct access to juvenile learners with some restrictions work online;
- Direct access to learners with no online activities – only classroom based.

The Handbook for the trainer on how to deliver the e-course will also be developed.



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
